Ply-Guard UR can either be applied directly to the substrate or with the aid of a primer.

Application

Ply-Guard UR should be applied through a two-component, high-pressure proportioning unit. Material and hoses should be heated to 150°F, and a minimal pressure of 2,200 psi.
